They are separated by a granular aggregate, doubtless crushed, in which occasionally clearer calcite crystals occur close to a larger fragment, formed either by its debris or under its lee. Cubes of pyrite, and products which result from its oxidation, are present. The rock is a schistose calcareous grit. 258, from the same moraine, a purplish-grey schistose rock, seemingly an impure limestone modified by pressure, bears considerable resemblance to the last both in the hand specimen and under the microscope, but is not quite so distinctly crushed, though a kind of foliation is perceptible. It appears to include a fair-sized fragment of a quartz-felspar...
