He served about two years until illness obliged him to resign. Rev. A. Wesley Bill (see page 63) enlisted as a private in Co. C, 66th Illinois Volunteer Infantry, Sept. 20th, 1861. He served as a private until Sept. 1st. 1864, and was then made regimental Hospital Steward. July 4th, 1865, he received commission as 1st Lieutenant and Assistant Surgeon. He was at Donelson, Shiloh and Corinth, served in the Atlanta campaign, Sherman s march to the sea, and was honorably discharged July 13th, 1865. Prof. J. J. Blaisdell was Chaplain of the 40th Wisconsin Volunteer Infantry. Prof. H. M. Whitney (see page 62) served some time in the Christian Commission, and then was in the United States army about one year, coming out of it as a Serjeant Major. Elder W. H. Beach (see p.95) enlisted May 1861, in Co. B, 1st New York...
